

The Exeter Dementia Action Alliance Cookies Policy

Like many other websites The Exeter Dementia Action Alliance stores and retrieves information on your browser using cookies. This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are and how we use them on our website.

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small piece of data that our website asks your browser to store on your computer or mobile device. It contains information that is not personally identifiable to you, but is used to improve your web experience. For example, a cookie can include the date and time of your visits to our website, the time spent.

Types of Cookies

There are two types of cookies:

Session Cookies and Persistent Cookies.

Session Cookies are deleted from your computer as soon as you close your browser. They are used to remember your browsing selection or provide you with secure access to some of the services on a website, e.g. login access to a user Area. Persistent Cookies remain stored on your computer until they are either deleted or expire. These are used to recognise you as a repeat visitor to a website which can adapt its content in line with your details.

How we use Cookies

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users and identify problems in order to improve our website. Should you give your consent, we will use cookies that enable us to gather more information on your preferences and tailor our website to your individual interests. Your Consent

Blocking and Disabling Cookies

Almost all browsers allow you to control the presence of cookies or block them automatically. If you block cookies, you can continue to use our website, although some services may be limited and you may not experience the full functionality of the site.
